Read Deut 10:17-22. In Genesis how was God revealed? How is God revealed in this passage?

How is history being used in this passage?

Read Deut. 12:2-7. What place is being described? What is the significance of that place?

Is the consolidation of power and of religion in one place part of God's plan?

How can you determine when God's plan and the plans of those in power coincide?

Read Deut. 14:28-29. What do you learn about God in this passage? Do you think this instruction was well received by those with wealth?

Read Deut. 15:7-11. Is this word conditioned by the worthiness of the recipient? Do you think there were lazy people in earlier times?

Read Deut 18:15-22. How might these words relate to Jesus?

Read Deut. 19:15-21. What is the purpose of this ordinance?

Read Deut. 20:1-9. What if this passage were followed by the military? What would happen?

Read Deut. 21:18-23. Do you think this passage was followed? Did king David follow this passage? Does this passage have anything to do with Jesus?

Deut. 22:13-21. Who or what is protected by this ordinance?

Read Deut. 22:22-29. Who is protected by this ordinance?

Read Deut. 23:1-2. What is the significance of Acts 8:26-40 in light of this passage?

Read Deut. 23:24-25. Do you see these verses as permission or limitation?

Read Deut. 24:14-15. What does this passage teach about God?

Read Deut. 25:11-12. If you had to preach a sermon on this passage what point would you make?
